The \$150 registration fee does NOT include lift tickets. As explained in the email distributed via adminskiracing, those that paid for Tussey lift tickets will be refunded through the adminskiracing system. Be prepared to purchase lift tickets directly through Roundtop Mountain Resort upon your arrival.

BANQUET: A banquet will be held on Saturday, most likely in the main lodge. It's tentative start time is upon completion of the SkillsQuest Tournament.

<u>SCHEDULE:</u> The race day schedules are tentative and will be confirmed each race day based on conditions and weather. You are responsible for verifying start times and locations on the day of the race. Please know that our goal is to provide the best on snow experience possible but weather and snow conditions are dictating the need to be patient and flexible.

Qualification for the State Team and invitations to the Piche' Invitational and Future Stars Festival will be determined by **New World Cup Points** based on the <u>TOTAL OF THE</u> <u>FINISHES OF ALL SIX RUNS</u> or as determined by circumstances and conditions (weather, snow, etc). Rules & Regulations:

Commemorative race bibs will be provided in your Registration Package for use at all weekend events. (You must have your bib to start.)

<u>All Racers</u> must stage their **equipment** in the designated "**staging area**" at the top of the race hill. No equipment is permitted in the race arena. **Please do not block skier traffic**.

Helmets are required per USSA Rules.

Other Information:

- 1. The scoreboard is unofficial.
- 2. Poor sportsmanship/use of inappropriate language will be dealt with as per USSA rules.
- 3. All protests must be filed in writing by **coaches** and must be accompanied by the proper fee of \$50. **Parents are not to approach Race Officials or Gate Judges regarding any issues.**Questions or protests must be directed to your coaches, who will approach the appropriate Race Officials.
- 4. Trophies and Medals will be awarded to the **top 8 male and female finishers** for Slalom and Giant Slalom.
- 5. Trophies will be awarded to the top overall Female and Male Skier.
- 6. New World Cup points will be used to score each run.
- 7. Medals will be awarded to the top 5 male and female scores in the SkillsQuest Tournament.
- 8. State Teams will be determined based on New World Cup points from each of the racers' six runs. Any ties will be broken using the inside/outside method.
- 9. Complimentary coaches' lift tickets will be issued not to exceed three per team. Available at course setting or at registration.
