Your invitation includes the 3 days of events as well as the athlete banquets.

DAY 1: Fri 2/22/19 - **Super G**- Training Run(s) on Race Hill and 1 Scored Run

DAY 2: Sat 2/23/19 - **Giant Slalom**- 2 Run Scored Race

DAY 3: Sun 2/24/19 - **Slalom**- 2 Run Scored Race

TEAM SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA FOR SELECTION TO PARA STATE TEAM

World Cup points will be accumulated from each day's race results. Team selection will be based on the highest aggregate number of World Cup points. Tie breaker methods apply as indicated in the PARA guide.

SG Awards- Awards for individual Super G will be based on the results of single SG run.

SL & GS AWARDS- Awards for individual Slalom and Giant Slalom will be determined by the combined run results for each discipline.

REGULATION HELMETS are mandatory for the Super G, Giant Slalom, and Slalom races

****USSA Specs for ski equipment will be enforced:**

SG: 183cm minimum length, 30m minimum radius

GS: no minimum length, 17m minimum radius

SL: 130cm minimum length, no minimum radius

RACE BIBS

Bibs for all three days for all events will be issued at registration. Bibs will be collected at the end of the 2nd run on Sunday, February 24, 2019. A bib deposit of \$20 cash will be collected at registration and returned to the racer after Sunday's race.

PARENT PARTICIPATION

It is requested for each racer to have a parent or friend gate judge or volunteer for at **least** one of the three event days. Volunteer sign-up sheets are available online at: <https://www.timetosignup.com/bluemtracing/>

SPECTATORS

Shuttle service is available between the Summit and the Valley for non-skiing spectators. Walkers can hike up the side of the Homestretch trail to the finish area. Walking Spectators MUST complete a Spectator release and will be provided with a complimentary Walking pass.

On Friday, Feb 23rd for the Super G, **NO spectators will be allowed on Razor's Edge**, the race trail. Spectators may observe from the Challenge trail, the service trail from Dreamweaver, or the connector just above "The Falls." **For safety reasons all spectators MUST remain at least 7ft behind the b-netting.** We recommend that spectators observe from the finish area.
