#### '22 PARA Coaches' Education Outcomes

In June 2021 the PARA Board allocated \$10,000 to subsidize and incentive, clubs and coaches to complete the USSS L100 Alpine Certification. Beginning the '23, all coaches will be required to have an active L100 or higher certification to act as a coach at USSS sanctioned competitions.

**Goal:** Increase the proportion of PARA coaches with the L100 or higher from 43% to 75% by the end of the '23 alpine competition season.
