Annual US Ski & Snowboard Alpine Officials Update Clinics are required bi-annually for all Alpine officials with CR, CC, JA, TC, RF, TD Certifications. The clinic is a general information update workshop, which will feature new and relevant information for this year's ski racing season.

1:30 PM - Exam Candidates sit for exams

- Chief of Course - CC

- Jury Advisor - JA (for Start and Finish Referees)

You must also include your name which workshop you are going to attend so that I have the proper number of exams available.
