### U14 State Championship

The event took place February 25th - 26th at Elk Mountain Ski Resort. This event was originally scheduled to take place at 7 Springs but mother nature did not cooperate and there was not sufficient coverage on the race hill for them to hold the race. Elk Mountain Ski Club stepped in to help pull this event off at the last minute to give the athletes the weekend of racing that they earned throughout the year. The field consisted of a total 81 athletes, 44 male and 37 female. The event included three runs of Slalom on Saturday and three runs of GS on Sunday. After the GS races on Sunday the awards ceremony was held to wrap up the Championship.

Overall this year the weather was not very favorable for our region and yet collectively we were able to pull off a successful season. As both the age chair and a coach I had the opportunity to spend the majority of my time on the slope. While both preparing and watching athletes throughout the course of the weekend I was impressed with the quality of racing as well as the behavior of the athletes. # Eastern Region Projects
