Venue

- Exhibition race slope is homologated for Slalom and GS
- Experienced and proven organizing committee and race staff
- Ski Roundtop management dedicated to providing an exceptional snow surface and support for junior racing (“whatever it takes mentality”)
- Competition Center at bottom of Exhibition with deck for spectators and indoor facility for athletes. 2019 saw the introduction of the Event Tent
- Large screen TV with Live Timing in common area of Comp Center
- PA system providing clear sound over entire course
- B-net inventory for venue requirements
- All Brush Grip base Junior gates

Support Staff & Volunteers

- Ongoing experienced RA, Timing crew and COR with race experience and club provides education for SRRRC volunteers on a weekly basis
- Annual gate judge education clinic for parents
- Mentoring and training program for AO’s
- Coordinator to organize and solicit volunteer positions
- Full support of all recommendations in the PARA Gate Judge program including pre-race solicitation and additional incentives for certified judges
- 12 Referee certified coaches on race staff

Timing

- Timing center in Competition Center provides exceptional view of course.
- One level 4, one level 3 and three level 1 T&C officials with 40+ years combined timing experience
- Additional RA certifications and experience
- Race documentation completed as much as possible prior to the end of each run
- World Cup points calculated immediately after each run
- New timing wires and junction boxes in 2011

- New finish wires will be run up the hill to accommodate a U12 more appropriate course length
- Live Timing displayed in Comp Center
- Recent timing upgrades support an efficiently run race

Officials & Coaches

- Coaches with significant experience producing races
- Most coaches have Referee and Level 100+ coaches' certifications
- Large coaching staff to help with course maintenance and venue preparation
- Many parents with various AO certifications

Skills TEAM Event in 2019 Additional Benefits

- This event will be scored and organized with help from participating coaches as leaders and scorers. The Skills Quest event will be held on Saturday morning, weather permitting.

Lodging, Banquet and Medical Facilities

- Six major medical centers within 30 minutes drive
- Many lodging options within 20 minutes drive
- Well run banquet at Event tent or quality venue

SRRC's Past Race Production History

- History of well-executed, on time, efficient races
- Ran "Derby In A Day" in 2011, putting SRRC's capabilities to the test with a very positive outcome and a great event.
- Ran a successful "back up" event in 2017 when challenging temperatures wiped out the scheduled mountains snow.
- Ran a new format and with a festival feel to the event in 2019

Proposed Schedule – February 28,29 and Mar 1, 2020

- Friday GS, Saturday Skills Quest and TEAM Event, Sunday Slalom and awards/team announcements
- Ticket prices weekday \$55 and Weekend \$65 for 2019 then 15% under 8 hour ticket price (weekday or weekend) in subsequent years. Subject to change. We are asking for lower pricing from new management

Scoring: As approved by PARA scoring Guidelines, historically 3 runs of GS, 3 runs of SL and using World Cup point scoring method.

DNF/DSQ: All racers permitted all runs

Fee: \$150 includes all racing, skills quest challenge, PARA head tax, Racers fee for the banquet on Saturday evening, giveaways

Requirements: For this event to work a minimum of 80 racers is necessary or we reserve a 20% fee increase in 2019 to cover rising costs
