## **Event Information**

<u>Run 2</u> - approximately 90 minutes after the completion of run 1. Please plan accordingly to be ready to inspect for the second run as <u>racers have no privileges in the lift lines</u>.

<u>Awards Ceremony</u> - approximately one hour after the completion of the second run.

<u>The lifts are not opened to racers and public until 8:00 am</u>. Racers and all other participants need to stay on the patio and keep off the snow in the base area; there may still be groomers in the base area until shortly before 8:00 am. In order to reach the race hill, exit the lift on the top to your right and follow Angel Drop to Homerun. Homerun is also visible from the main lift.

<u>Discounted lift tickets</u> (\$71.00 or \$67 for children 12 & under) will be sold at the designated ticket window for racers and their families from 7:15 am. List of registered racers will be at that window. You do not need to have your bib in hand to purchase discounted tickets.

<u>Walk passes are required</u> for all non-skiing spectators. Walk pass (looks like a lift ticket) is free but you will need to sign a release. Walk passes can be obtained at the race registration or a ticket window with a signed release form which is attached to this announcement and will be also available at the registration.

<u>The racer, volunteer and walk release forms</u> will be distributed before the race and only limited number of forms will be available at the registration. If possible, please <u>fill out your form in advance</u> to make the registration more efficient. All uphill walking traffic – please remain on the right-hand side of the trail as you ascend.

Official <u>posting board</u> (results, DQs etc.) will be located at the timing building (start). Times on the hand-written posting board at the finish area and on https://livetiming.usskiandsnowboard.org/ are unofficial.

<u>Absolutely no free skiing on the race hill</u> – lease respect the instructions of the race organizers and coaches during the course inspection to ensure good conditions for all racers throughout the race.

<u>Confine skiing</u> at race speeds to the race course - fast or reckless skiing outside the race course will result in <u>loss</u> of skiing privileges at Whitetail.
